Assoc. Prof. Dr Endah Triastuti is an expert in media anthropology, with a focus on digital ethnography, studying how people engage with digital media in their daily lives and cultures. She combines qualitative and quantitative methods in her research. Endah holds a PhD in Media and Communications from the University of Wollongong, Australia, where her thesis explored Indonesian women's blogging and identity construction. Her publications cover a wide range of topics, including the creation of media museums to foster nationalism, digital literacy in underprivileged ASEAN communities, and the mediated politics of the precariat during the pandemic in neoliberal Indonesia.

She has also written extensively on the use of social media by sexual violence survivors seeking justice, gender expression recognition for transgender individuals, and the digital strategies of Indonesian gay communities. Her research highlights the intersection of digital media with social and cultural issues, emphasizing marginalized voices and experiences.
